- DIVISION RESTRICTIONS:
 - Leadline—8 years old & under. May cross enter into Beginner Trail only.
 - Walk—10 years old & under. May cross enter into Beginner Trail only.
 - Jr. Walk-Trot Equitation 12"—13 years old & under. May cross enter into Novice Western Rider, & Junior Trail.
 - Sr. Walk-Trot Equitation 12"—14 years old & older. May cross enter into Green Horse & Pony, Novice Western Rider, & Senior Trail.
 - Green Horse & Pony 12"—Open to English & Western horses. Year-end champion horse or ponies are no longer eligible to compete in this division.
 - Jr. Mini-Stirrup W/T/C 18"—13 years old & under. Year-end champions are no longer eligible to compete in this division.
 - Sr. Mini-Stirrup W/T/C 18"—14 years old & over. Year-end champions are no longer eligible to compete in this division.
 - Jr. Short Stirrup W/T/C 2′—13 years old & under. Year-end champions are no longer eligible to compete in this division.
 - Sr. Short Stirrup W/T/C 2′—14 years old & over. Year-end champions are no longer eligible to compete in this division.
 - 2'3" Equitation W/T/C—No age restriction.
 - 2'6" Equitation W/T/C—No age restriction.
 - English Pleasure Pony & English Pleasure Horse 2 divisions may be combined if there are fewer than 6 entries in each division.
 - English Pleasure Park Hack may include Back, Sitting Trot, Extended Gaits, and Collected Gaits.
 - Pony Hunter and Horse Hunter 2'3" divisions may be combined if there are fewer than 6 entries in each division.
 - Novice Western Rider—W/J Any age. May only cross enter into W/T and W/J division and Trail.
 - Trail—Open to English & Western. Beginner, Junior and Senior trail will run simultaneously. These classes will be open 11am-2pm.
 - Beginner Trail—Horse/Rider combinations may only cross enter into Leadline and Walk Divisions.
- ENTRIES—\$6.00 PER CLASS, for pre-entries received by Wednesday before each show. Thursday through Sunday entries will be \$10 PER CLASS. There will be a \$6.00 ring fee per rider. Leadline riders excluded.
- COGGINS—All entries **must** present a current negative coggins dated within one year of show date. A copy must be provided to the entry booth to keep on file.
- SEI approved helmets with harness are **required** on **ALL** mounted riders on grounds.
- All riders' ages are as of January 1 of the current year.
 - Juniors—13 years old & under as of 1/1. Seniors—14 years old & over as of 1/1.
- Audits should flip their numbers over to the blank side so no numbers are shown.
- Proper attire **must** be worn in all classes (unless excused by Judge).
- Six (6) ribbons will be awarded in all classes.
- Champion & Reserve Champion will be awarded in all divisions.
- All points are awarded on **same** rider/mount combination. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- The points from all 5 shows will accumulate and series awards will be presented at our annual awards banquet. You must show in the same division in at least 2 shows to be eligible for year-end awards in that division. Our awards banquet will be held on January 21, 2017. We will begin to take reservations on September 11, 2016.
- No dogs allowed. NO EXCEPTIONS. No one allowed in barn area. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- No alcoholic beverages allowed. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- No smoking allowed anywhere on the property. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- The show committee reserves the right to refuse entries or to change, combine or cancel classes with fewer than 4 entries.
- Anyone displaying poor sportsmanship will be asked to leave the grounds. COACHING FROM SIDELINES IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED.
- Understanding that horse sports may be hazardous & dangerous, even leading to permanent injury or death, each owner, rider, spectator, and other participants assumes any AND all risk of loss or injury and agrees to hold harmless, regardless of negligent acts or omissions, the Linthicum 4-H Hi-Riders/Easy Rider Ranch, the organizer, show committee, and all other personnel.

Directions

FROM NORTH & WEST: Take Balt. Beltway (695) to exit 11B for Interstate 95 S toward Washington. Take exit 47A on the left for Interstate 195 E toward BWI Thurgood Marshall Airport. Take exit 3 for Washington Boulevard/U.S. 1 toward Elkridge. Turn right onto U.S. 1 S/Washington Blvd. Turn left onto Levering Ave. Turn left onto Main St. Take the 1st right onto Furnace Ave. Turn right onto Ridge Rd. Take the 2nd right onto German Driveway. Destination will be on the left.

FROM EAST: From 695, take exit 8 toward Maryland 168, Merge onto Fairview Ave. Turn right onto Nursery Rd. Take the 2nd right onto River Rd. Take the 1st right onto Furnace Ave. Take the 1st left onto Ridge Rd. Take the 2nd right onto German Driveway. Destination will be on the left.

FROM SOUTH: From MD-176 W/Dorsey Rd. Slight right toward MD-170 N/Aviation Blvd. Continue straight onto MD-170 N/Aviation Blvd. Slight right toward Stoney Run Rd. Turn left onto Stoney Run Rd. Turn right onto Corporate Center Dr. At the traffic circle, take the 1st exit onto Ridge Rd. Turn left onto German Driveway. Destination will be on the left.

Riders may only ride in one of the shaded divisions regardless of mount. These are equitation classes and are judged on the rider.
